Booking your appointment

When contacting the surgery to book your CASA aviation please be aware, we will require the below information -

Full name, contact details, address, phone number and Medicare information.

What Class medical you require(see below) and your ARN number. Please advise reception if and ECG or pathology is required prior to your appointment.

We will also require a \$275 deposit at your time of booking to secure your appointment. If for any reason you need to cancel a refund will be provided, if we are notified with at least 4 hours' notice.

What type of Medical do you require?

Class I Initial/Renewal, Class II Initial/Renewal, Qantas Aircrew/Cabin Crew Medical or Other (eg. International airline medical or international air force medical).

Class I Initial

- 1. Complete medical questionnaire on MRS and pay CASA.
- 2. Audiogram routine occupational audiogram do not need referral for this. To be done prior to appointment if possible ?hearing Australia
- 3. Bloods Cholesterol, HDL, LDL, Trigs + Fasting Glucose. Can get regular GP to request, or we can request. To bring results to appointment if done externally.
- 4. ECG can be done at time of appointment
- 5. Ophthalmology review. Applicant to check CASA website for DAO (designated aviation ophthalmologist) do not need referral for this.

Class II Initial

1. Complete medical questionnaire on MRS and pay CASA.

Class I & II reviews:

- 1. Complete medical questionnaire on MRS and pay CASA.
- 2. Complete any requirements as per CASA (should be notified of what these are when logging on to complete medical questionnaire. All requirements except ECG if required to be completed prior to appointment

Qantas Aircrew

- 1. Complete medical questionnaire
- 2. Complete blood tests as per medical form. FBE, E/LFT, Chol, HDL, LDL, Trigs + Fasting Glucose.
- 3. Immunisation records (immunisations can be arranged here if required at additional cost).
- 4. Audiogram routine occupational audiogram do not need referral for this
- 5. Eye check complete Qantas eye check form
- 6. Drug and alcohol screen to be completed through Sonic Heathcare as per Qantas Medical form.
- 7. Bring all required documentation to appointment.

Qantas Cabin Crew

- 1. Complete medical questionnaire
- 2. Immunisation records (immunisations can be arranged here if required at additional cost).
- 3. Audiogram routine occupational audiogram does not need referral for this
- 4. Drug and alcohol screen to be completed through Sonic Heathcare as per Qantas Medical form.
- 5. Bring all required documentation to appointment.

Pre-Appointment Checklist

- Bring Photo ID to appointment
- Complete and submit your online Aviation medical BEFORE appointment
- Bring along any recent test results you have completed
- Bring along any corrective glasses or contact lenses and optometry/ophthalmology reports you have
